

## **SPECIAL GUIDELINES AND AGREEMENT TO ADDRESS COVID-19**

Attached BARRC Event Waiver must be signed by all exhibitors and spectators

**AKC Best Practices for the Well-Being of Dog Sport Participants and any Solano Community College, State of California, and CDC health orders will be practiced. Given the present status of the COVID-19 epidemic we will hold our Trial with the safety of our exhibitors, volunteers and dogs in mind.**

**First and foremost**, we ask that all participants who have symptoms (including, but not limited to, fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat) of COVID-19 not attend the event.

Responses to the CDC COVID Questionnaire and Temperature Screening will be required at check in. Anyone with temperature of 100.4 or above, or who answers 'Yes' to any of the CDC questions, will be excluded from attending/participating.

*We will refund any entries should people need to withdraw due to symptoms COVID-19 or an answer of 'Yes' to any of the CDC screening questions.*

**Social Distancing** will be practiced throughout this event. When standing in line for inspection, please maintain at least 6 feet of distance from the person ahead of you in line. Exhibitors should maintain at least 6 feet of distance from each other while releasing and catching dogs. Please be aware of the running order, and do not crowd around the event board or trial secretary's table.

We will have hand sanitizer and wet wipes available in common areas.

**Masks** covering nose and mouth must be worn when not in your car, RV, etc.

*Anyone not following these safety protocols will be asked to leave the event without entry refund after one reminder.*

**Hospitality.** No food will be served by the host club. Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs.

***Finally, by entering this event, you are acknowledging the contagious nature of COVID- 19 and voluntarily assume the risk that you may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the club's event, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability and possibly death.***

A completed and signed waiver is required for all entrants. The waiver is attached to this premium and must be returned with entries or entries will be deemed incomplete.

Copies will be available on site for completion by all other people in attendance.

**JC/QC Test Check-In & Inspection starting at 9 am; dogs will be run as they check in [Judge: J Gysler]**

**Trial Check-In & Inspection: Closes with Roll Call at 11:00 am or 1 hr after conclusion of RR breed judging at the Sacramento Valley Dog Fanciers Association show, whichever occurs latest, followed by the draw & running of the Trial**

Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. *Early acceptance of hounds for members of the field committee may begin prior to published test or trial hours.*

**ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY--** Lure Coursing tests and trials shall be open to eligible Rhodesian Ridgebacks one year of age or older. Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may not be entered. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.

**Qualified Coursers and ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open or Veteran Stake**

**Ribbons will be offered for all placements and Test Qualifiers**

**Best of Breed • Purple & Gold Rosette**

**Trophies will be provided for BOB and winners of each stake**

**THE NORTHSTAR CHALLENGE TROPHY** plaque offered by friends in memory of 'Aja', BIF DC Deer Ridge Spot of Gold, SC, FCH, ROM, for competition at the BARRC AKC Specialty Lure Trial only. For permanent possession, BOB to be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive trials. Name of winning dog, owner, and date will be engraved.

DIRECTIONS: Turn left out of the college onto Suisun Valley Rd.  
Continue over the freeway on Pittman Rd-- turn left on Central Pl, turn right on Lookout Hill Rd. Clinic is on the left.

### **TESTS OFFERED:**

The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four (4) turns.

**JUNIOR COURSER (JC):** A hound running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

**QUALIFIED COURSER (QC):** A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.**

### **STAKES OFFERED:**

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

**SPECIAL:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.

Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles.

**OPEN VETERAN:** Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club - 7 years of age for Rhodesian Ridgebacks. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

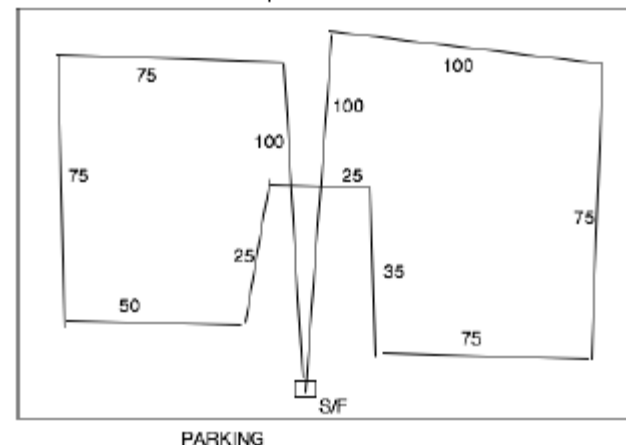
**Singles Stake:** Open to all hounds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.

Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for hounds excused during inspection for bitches in season, lameness, or disqualifications will be refunded. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds that have not been neutered are ineligible to participate in the regular stakes. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.

**Please bring your own shade. Parking is on the road edge of the field. PLEASE NOTE: This field is not completely fenced. A Port-a-Potty with hand sanitizer will be available. BARRC assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during, or after these Tests/Trials.**

**Equipment:** Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white or colored plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the Bay Area Rhodesian Ridgeback Club reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test/trial.
